This Bulletin is issued for the purpose of amending certain requirements of the original Contract Documents, as noted hereinafter, and is hereby made part of and incorporated in full force as part of the Contract Documents. Unless specifically noted or specified hereinafter, all work shall comply with the applicable provisions of the Contract Documents.

A) BIDDING INFORMATION

1. Contractors are advised that bids are due on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>November 24, 2020 by 2:00 PM at the DPMC Plan Room</u>. Firms planning to submit a bid can drop off the bid to the DPMC Plan Room or use an overnight delivery service. <u>However</u>, <u>bids not received by the bid deadline will be deemed non-responsive</u>. Bidders are permitted to attend the bid opening in person (limit one representative per firm to ensure proper social distancing measures) but are strongly urged due to the current COVID-19 pandemic emergency to view the bid opening via the ZOOM videoconferencing app instead of attending in person. The bid results will be posted on the DPMC website promptly after the opening.

a) To Join the Bid Opening via the Zoom app:

- O You can connect with a PC/laptop or with an iOS or Android phone.

B) REVISIONS TO THE SPECIFICATIONS

- Specification Section 088000 Glazing:
 - 1. Paragraph 2.1, A, 1 Amend to Read '1. Vitro Architectural Glass (Basis of Design)'
 - 2. Paragraph 2.5, B, 1 Amend to Read '1. Basis of Design Optigray + Solarban 60 (3)'
 - 3. Paragraph 3.8, A, 4 Amend to Read '4. Light Transmission: 50%'
 - 4. Paragraph 3.8, A, 5 Amend to Read '5. U-Value: 0.29'
 - 5. Paragraph 3.8, A, 6 Amend to Read '6. Shading Coefficient: 0.35'
 - 6. Paragraph 3.8, A, 7 Add the following '7. Basis of Design Optigray + Solarban 60 (3)'
 - 7. Paragraph 3.8, B Amend to Read 'Type G-2: Insulated Glass equal to G-1, except with outer and inner pane of ¼" thick, tinted, fully tempered glass and vinyl Motor Vehicle Logo on outside pane. Color to match NJMVC Standard.'
 - 8. Paragraph 3.8, C Amend to Read 'Type G-3: Insulated Glass equal to G-1, except with outer and inner pane of 1/4" thick, tinted, fully tempered glass.'

C) RESPONSES TO CONTRACTOR QUESTIONS

Magnum, Inc.

1. Please consider waiving the AISC certification for the Structural Steel contractor. The contractor must already be DPMC approved and, by eliminating the extra requirement, GC's will be able to provide more competitive pricing to the DPMC.

Answer: Wherever there is a reference to AISC Certification: neither the Contractor nor the Fabricator is required to be AISC Certified, but all related work must conform to the AISC Standards referenced in the currently adopted building code.

2. Please confirm that the DPMC anticipates a Jan. 1, 2021 NTP date for this project, as discussed in the pre-bid site visit?

Answer: No. The Notice to Proceed (NTP) will be issued as soon as possible.

3. There seems to be some conflicting data in the Glazing spec: Basis of design is stated to be Viracon, but for Low E coated float glass, the Solarban 60 is a Vitro product. Additionally, the Solarban 60, according to our glazier's distributor, does not meet the requirements listed under 088000-11.3.8.A "Glass Unit Schedule" – Solarban 70 would be needed to meet this spec. Please advise on which products/manufacturers bidders should base their pricing.

Answer: See Item B, Revisions to Specifications above.

4. Please provide "MVCNJ standard" signage data for exterior signage?

Answer: See Item B, Revisions to Specifications above.

Eastern Construction & Electric, Inc.

1. Specification calls for <u>a separate DPMC field office</u> with toilet on page # 43-4.20 where as section 015000-2.2 Temp facilities calls <u>for "DPMC/Contractor common use field office".</u>

Answer: A DPMC Field Office will not be required for this project. See Bulletin A, Item D (Amendments to the General Conditions of the Contract), Item 4.20 DPMC Field Office.

2. The limit of disturbance as shown on SW-1 is different than SW-2, The existing CDL road test area is not included in the SW-1?

Answer: The contractor is responsible to field locate and document the existing striping and markings of the existing CDL Test Area. Also, the contractor is responsible to mill and overlay, 1-1/2" of the existing CDL test area in accordance with the contract plans and specifications. The limit of disturbance shown on SW-1 does not include the existing CDL Test Area since by the definition for Limit of Disturbance from the Soil Erosion Standards is when soil is exposed and the milling and overlay of the existing pavement for the CDL test area would not be considered disturbance to the Soil Conservation District. The contractor is responsible to perform the site work as shown on the contract plans and specifications.

3. Section 015000- Is land line required for the trailer office? (015000 -2.2B-10)

Answer: A DPMC Field Office will not be required for this project. See Bulletin A, Item D (Amendments to the General Conditions of the Contract), Item 4.20 DPMC Field Office. Should the Contractor require their own Field Office, it is the responsibility of the Contractor to obtain and acquire all UCC Permits required.

4. Private toilet inside common trailer – is it for DPMC? (015000-2.2-B4)

Answer: A DPMC Field Office will not be required for this project. See Bulletin A, Item D (Amendments to the General Conditions of the Contract), Item 4.20 DPMC Field Office. Contractor shall supply portable toilets.

5. You need Copier/fax/printer only for DPMC? can it be shared with General Contractor?(015000-2.2B9)?

Answer: A DPMC Field Office will not be required for this project. See Bulletin A, Item D (Amendments to the General Conditions of the Contract), Item 4.20 DPMC Field Office.

Ocean Construction, LLC

- 1. Under manufacturers, basis of design is Viracon.
 - Under low E coated float glass, basis of design is Solarban 60, which is Vitro, not Viracon product.
 - Under glass unit schedule, they give values, and a quick review from our distributor tells me that Solarban 60 doesn't not meet those, you would need Solarban 70.

Answer: See Item B, Revisions to Specifications above.
